

Pre-Operative Instructions for Catheter Insertion/Exchange

Please follow instructions prior to your appointment Day of Procedure:

- 1. **Do NOT** take any sort of blood thinners for **48 hours** prior to your procedure. (Examples include Aspirin, Coumadin, Wafarin) *If you have any questions regarding your medications, please check with your primary physician, kidney doctor and/or cardiologist.*
- 2. Do NOT eat or drink anything 4 hours prior to your scheduled appointment! (this is due to <u>possible</u> use of sedation during procedure)
- 3. Do NOT take any diabetic medication the morning of your procedure. Assistance will be provided to properly maintain blood glucose levels.
- 4. Please bring all of your medications with you.
- 5. Bring a responsible adult to accompany you after the procedure. You will NOT be allowed to drive <u>if</u> you are sedated during your procedure.
- 6. You may experience a delay in starting your procedure. We appreciate your patience; as we receive emergencies from many dialysis centers.
