

## **Pre-Operative Instructions for Catheter Removals**

- **Do NOT** take any blood thinner medication **48 hours** prior to your procedure to remove your catheter. Please call the office if you have any questions regarding this issue. (Coumadin and warfarin, Aspirin, etc.)
- Sedation is not used for this procedure however the area will be numbed with lidocaine for patient comfort. There is no need for a driver for this procedure.
- Please allow adequate time for your procedure. In some cases there may be a delay starting your procedure, since we receive many emergencies from dialysis centers. We ask for your patience and understanding in this matter.
- If you are not able to keep your appointment and/or need to reschedule, please call our appointment desk at **409-347-7290**, they will be more than happy to assist you.
